namely how states interact in a society of nation states although sheehan treats these three dimensions of the political order separately they are closely bound together each dependent on and reinforcing the others ultimately he claims the modern nation state must balance all three organizing principles if it is to succeed sheehan s project begins with an examination of people s expectations about political space community and international society in the premodern european world that came to be called the ancien régime he then in chapters on states nations and the society of nation states proceeds to trace the development of a modern political order that slowly and unevenly replaced the ancien régime in europe and eventually spread throughout the world to close he offers some speculations about the horizon ahead of us beyond which lies a future order that may someday replace our own
