Alice in Wonderand - With 42 Original Illustrations by Sir John Tenniel (Aziloth Books) 2011-02-01 alice s adventures in wonderland is the world s first surrealist book written in 1865 at a time when the word surrealism had not yet been invented the author of this dream like fantasy full of puns and ironic comments on adult life was lewis carroll real name charles dodgson who devised the story for three young girls during a boat trip on the river isis in oxford since its publication alice s adventures in wonderland has been a firm favourite with children of all ages and adults too can find deeper layers of meaning beneath the madcap adventures of alice and her outlandish army of comic characters the story has been translated into 125 different languages and after the bible koran and shakespeare is the most frequently quoted book in the world

**Black Beauty** 2014-11-04 black beauty is the absorbing tale of a fine spirited colt who begins life with a sympathetic owner in an idyllic country setting told from the point of view of the horse itself the book follows the life of black beauty as he is sold to various masters some of whom are indifferent to animal suffering anna sewell s genius lies in making the world of the horse with its own joys jealousies hopes and anxieties as real to us as that of any human although now famed as a children's classic sewell originally wrote the book as a reaction to the inhuman treatment meted out to horses in victorian england in this she was very successful from its first publication in 1877 black beauty has had a huge impact altering public perceptions of animal welfare and spurring legislation to protect both horses and donkeys

woodward s beautiful colour illustrations and numerous line drawings peter pan is a wild fantasy adventure full of magical people and places and shot through with all the quirky funny little thoughts of childhood but j m barrie s tale is more than just a simple fairy tale barrie is keen to point out the value of family and that despite the wonders of neverland it is not a place to stay in forever the real world should be our playground

The Jungle Books 2014-09-08 rudyard kipling was born in india in 1865 and spent his early years reveling in the country's exotic delights at five he was sent to school in england and did not returned until 1882 when he worked as a reporter on the civil and military gazette a prolific writer he soon became famous for a prodigious range of tales and poems from the high adventure of the man who would be king through the gritty doggerel of barrack room ballads to charming children's story such as puck of pooks hill and perhaps his most celebrated offering the jungle book although it includes such famous tales as rikki tikki tavi the jungle books true hero is mowgli a young boy raised with wolves and hunted by the evil tiger shere khan all is well until the realization dawns in mowgli that he is human knowledge he tries to repress as he is appalled by humankind's greed and destructiveness through a series of perils and adventures mowgli gradually comes to terms with the animal and human facets of his life like all good children's stories these tales have a depth of allegory and symbolism that allows them to be enjoyed by adults as well as children the jungle book is a work that can be read throughout a lifetime one that will bring pleasure and further insights at each reading

(Aziloth Books) 2015-03-30 born in london in 1757 william blake soon showed evidence of his artistic talent his father a hosier encouraged the boy s gifts and blake was apprenticed at 14 to the engraver james basire after which he began illustrating and printing his own works of poetry first published in 1789 songs of innocence was followed four years later by songs of experience with a combined edition reaching the bookstalls in 1794 the two collections explore the naive joys of childhood and the darker more jaundiced view that life imposes as the infant grows to maturity but blake does not use this dichotomy to bemoan a sentimental loss of innocence rather he uses the poems to reveal the limitations of both views dark and evil forces do exist in the world and it is foolish to ignore them but equally joy and love pervade the universe and to deny their presence is equally undiscerning in blake s view we need both to progress a thesis that is explored in detail in his second work the marriage of heaven and hell more than 50 colour illustrations taken from the originals of both works are scattered throughout the text in accordance with blake s own belief that his poems and paintings form an integral whole these are works of great depth and discrimination that reveal further levels of understanding and greater insight into the mysteries of human existence with each successive reading.
