required institutional tests of writing the author has been able to pull together a more complete picture of writing and intellectual development over the college years than has previously been available in any study students are seen to acquire the ability to handle more complex reasoning tasks as they find themselves in more challenging intellectual settings and where risk taking and exploration of new ideas are valued the integration of students previous life experiences into their academic studies allows them to analyze critique modify and apply their previously held world views to their new learning these changes are seen to occur over time with instructional settings and support providing key roles in writing development personal factors in students lives present difficulties that require persistence and dedication to overcome never before have the complexities of real individual lives as they affect academic performance been so clearly presented
