at the turn of the twentieth century arthur wesley dow literally wrote the book on composition and this is it dow s composition exercised an enormous influence on emerging modern artists of a century ago a thought provoking examination of the nature of visual representation it remains ever relevant to all the visual arts a well known painter and printmaker dow taught for many years at columbia university and acted as a mentor to countless young artists including georgia o keeffe his text presented in a workbook format offers teachers and students a systematic approach to composition it explores the creation of freely constructed images based on harmonic relations between lines colors and dark and light patterns the author draws upon the traditions of japanese art to discuss a theory of flat formal equilibrium as an essential component of pictorial creation practical and well illustrated this classic guide offers valuable insights into modern design

in writing this book my main purpose is to set forth a way of thinking about art the most that such a book can do is to direct the thoughts awaken a sense of power and point to ways of controlling it the principles of art teaching here outlined might be illustrated in other ways and with better examples i hope the reader will see how each chapter can be developed into many sets of lessons the progressions can be varied materials changed lessons amplified and different designs chosen providing there is no sacrifice of essentials the book is based upon my experience in painting and teaching for more than twenty years the first edition of composition was published in 1899 in this revision i have made many additions and used new illustrations without departing from theory or principles composition was chosen as a title because that word expresses the idea upon which the method here presented is founded the putting together of lines masses and colors to make a harmony design understood in its broad sense is a better word but popular usage has restricted it to decoration

ezra pound is one of the most significant poets of the twentieth century a writer whose poetry is particularly notable for the intensity of its linguistic qualities indeed from the principles of imagism to the polyphony of his cantos pound is central to our conception of modernism s relationship with language this volume explores the development of pound s understanding of language in the context of twentieth century linguistics and the philosophy of language it draws on largely unpublished archival material in order to provide a broadly chronological account of the development of pound s views and their relation to both his own poetry and to modernist writing as a whole beginning with pound s contentious relationship with philology and his antagonism towards academia the book traces continuities and shifts across pound s career culminating in a discussion of the centrality of language to the conception of his cantos while it contains discussions around significant figures in twentieth century linguistic thought such as ferdinand de saussure and ludwig wittgenstein the book attempts to recover the work of theorists such as leonard bloomfield lucien lévy bruhl and c k ogden figures who were once central to modernism but who have largely been pushed to the

periphery of modernist studies the picture of pound that emerges is a figure whose understanding of language is not only bound up with modernist approaches to anthropology politics and philosophy but which calls for a new understanding of modernism s relationship to each

edna boies hopkins 1872 1937 is best known for herfloral woodblock prints that range from delicate japanese inspiredstylizations to boldly colored and progressivelymodernist works in her brief twenty year career hopkins producedseventy four known woodblock prints including figurativework and landscapes as well as floral compositions this catalogueraisonné is the first in depth study of this once well known americanartist it illustrates all of hopkins s known prints related drawings andstudies born in hudson michigan hopkins attended the art academy of cincinnatifrom 1895 to 1898 in 1899 she took classes with the influential artist arthurwesley dow an advocate of japanese art following her marriage in 1904 hopkinsand her husband settled in paris where they remained until the outbreakof world war i after returning to america hopkins became part of a smallgroup of artists in provincetown whose innovations in woodblock printmakinghave come to be known as the provincetown print or the white line woodcut in1917 a visit to the cumberland falls region of kentucky provided the inspirationfor some of hopkins s most important prints which predate the work ofamerican regionalist painters and printmakers by a decade or more in addition to the catalogue raisonné edna boies hopkins includes much new biographical research along with a census of her prints and a comprehensive list of her exhibitions exhibition dates columbus museum of art columbus
