this volume is a vision of spanish literature seen through pirandellian eyes those themes and techniques which pirandello stamped with his name have actually characterized a segment of spanish writing from the time of cervantes professor newberry first examines those writers who preceded pirandello or could not have felt his influence and then those who acknowledged the italian s mastery or who wrote in the ambience he created she emphasizes how old are the spanish themes that illusion and reality intermingle that life is fiction and fiction life that madness is often saner or preferable to sanity meticulously she chronicles the spaniards use of techniques associated with these themes the play within a play the theater that mingles fiction and life the breakdown of barriers between audience and stage the autonomous character beginning with cervantes s don quijote where madness and sanity change the very nature of reality and illusion she moves forward to calderón s el gran teatro del mundo and other relevant works between lope de vega and galdós the author devotes a special chapter to the género chico and particularly the sainetes of ramón de la cruz for these works kept pirandellian concepts alive during the somewhat infertile eighteenth century after examining echegaray whose romantic works she shows to be only part of his contribution professor newberry turns to ramón whom she skillfully links to the cubist school of painting there follows an extended discussion of unamuno particularly his novel niebla with its famous autonomous character augusto pérez the second part of this book deals with those authors aware of pirandello and his work professor newberry begins with azorín whose enthusiasm for and understanding of pirandello and the tendencies associated with him are greater than those of any other spanish writer her brief examination of the machado brothers shows how they have taken pirandello s investigation into being and seeming and translated it into their own terms because his most popular work is not pirandellian few people have ever observed pirandellian aspects in garcía lorca s writing but el público and other works certainly contribute to this book casona on the other hand is enveloped by what azorín described as the pirandellian mist although casona s treatment of how reality and illusion intermingle is uniquely his own not limiting herself to discussing grau s el señor de pigmalion a play often considered in relation to pirandello professor newberry brings up three other works that clearly indicate grau s involvement in these themes and techniques indeed one of his plays even incorporates a character pirandello rejected and rarely have spanish playwrights broken down the barriers between stage and audience so completely as grau does in tabarín luca de tena is shown to raise most pirandellian problems in his plays but unlike the italian he systemically rules in favor of life his conflicts are lighter and their resolution is happier pedro salinas the last author professor newberry considers at length is rarely studied as a playwright but his plays show the characteristic imprint of pirandello fiction and reality are confused there are problems of identity he uses the autonomous character nonetheless salinas s basic view of life is diametrically opposed to pirandello s for he is filled with love joy optimism and faith in the possibility of clarifying reality finally the author looks at the arte nuevo group particularly sastre and palacio and she also considers sotelo who like the other two was influenced not only by pirandello but also by thornton wilder professor newberry provides a consistently interesting picture of how spanish literature has always shown great interest in those themes and techniques

we have come to call pirandellian and how it has given them a stamp uniquely its own in an appendix the author includes a brief discussion of the spanish works found in pirandello s study

the essays in this collection which were written by european and north american specialists position intermediality as a praxis of interpretative analysis in order to show how intermediality challenges our notion of art the writers examine the various intermedial relations between the arts which may take the form of reference to another form of art a combination of two or more forms of art or a generic transformation from one form of art to another in such cases an intermedial approach helps us to grasp the changing relationship between the arts which affects our reception of experience intermediality has profoundly changed our understanding of interdisciplinary relations formerly examined in the field of interart studies by introducing a medial aspect intermediality has succeeded in making a leap from past practices of artistic interrelatedness to our contemporary medial age in which literature along with other arts may be understood as a medium this ambitious undertaking has contributed to the liberation of literature and other arts from an isolated position in the established scholarly landscape with its clear cut borderlines between disciplines the essays in this collection are a valuable contribution to this on going discussion about the relationships between the arts the variety of essays published in this collection makes it an excellent introduction to academics and university students in such disciplines as literature music theatre art history and media studies due to its clarity which does not sacrifice philosophical depth concerning the role of intermedial studies for several forms of art this book will also be of interest to academics and students who are currently working at advanced level art schools

who are intellectuals what do they think their role and function in contemporary society is are they on the endangered species list is equating conservatism with conservation becoming their dominant survival strategy this book is a collection of essays that examines some of the changes in the activities role function and self perception of italian intellectuals since world war ii two major divides are considered to be the crisis of 1956 7 and the fall of the berlin wall the first section examines some of the most influential figures in the early decades the second the activities of contemporary intellectuals a third gives voice to some contemporary writers a fourth contains some comparative essays about the role of intellectuals in influential contemporary western cultures and a final section is devoted to some cross disciplinary forays and reflections on the relevance and possible future directions of these inquiries

once bukowski was asked do you believe in god he replied no i believe only in horses i do not know why we always realize things when it is too late ive also bet on horses for a period but differently from bukowski whom i respect so much i quit horses and bet on god really i think it is for this faith that i found myself with my back against the wall against the wall was the first title i wanted to give to this book there are a lot of people in the world tramps prisoners all types of emarginated people who are alienated just because in my opinion they do not manage to keep pace with a cheering occidental cult of efficiency to keep up with the rules for which the society the system did not forgive them but christ said i came to the world for the ill not for the sane thus is it really true the last will be the first maybe if as far as i know a probable god does not consider things the way people do anyway what i have never understood is there is a baby born from gypsies and there is another one born from a rich american family what is the fault of the first one whose destiny is immediately signed a mystery so a gemstone in the rock in its essential message is an invitation to bet on god as it is the only chance we have in our life it is also an invitation to prayto pray more often during the day even at work but without putting the entertainment aside it gives colours to our life thats why the title is a gemstone in the rock life is nothing but a precious stone in the rock you can observe it in its splendour but you cannot take it with your naked hands as far as the emarginated people are concerned let us help them bearing in mind that differently from what the main part of respectable catholics think to help them is not at all a walk of pleasure i say it with a poem how much pain i get for a kiss to a poor wretch this book has got a particular it is like a human being in the course of his life with its high and low moments between faith and total loss of courage p s as far as my poem now faith is concerned for a question of a dramaturgic effect i left the sequence of the passion events according to my poetic license have a good time reading sincerely donato placido this book was born as a synthesis of our writings our thoughts and vision of the world i made donatos acquaintance while he was focused on hypotheses of a staged version of a pirandellos play his poetry published and appreciated in italy inspired me i proposed to him being published abroad i read donatos material thoroughly and put it in a sequence i would rather say i had to cut it like a movie his writings evoke movie like images this book owes to me its structure order and some chapters trilogy loneliness of light i wrote on the basis of apocryphal gospels found in the dead sea in 2004 in particular judas and magdalenes gospels however the dialogue between judas and magdalene staged in 2006 in moscow at an international festival of directing plays and magdalenes monologue are of pure intuition or if we prefer so of artistic invention other book parts of which i am the author are the dialogue puppets of freedom inspired by dantons death by georg bchner extracts from disillusion money power female love extracts from absence and silence the end of the world silence loneliness and the whole chapter of encounter which is donatos novel of the same name i put in a nutshell and in blank verse and my poem on a true love till the darkness in a human life everyone passes from happiness to despair from the idea of god dissolved in everything to the idea of his absence one stakes on the material goods accumulation on power on love even on the idea of freedombut then one notices all these concepts are only illusions just glimpses

the neu med project is part of the horizon 2020 programme in the erc advanced project category it began in october 2015 and will be concluded in october 2020 the university of siena is the host institution of the project the project is focussed upon two tuscan riverine corridors leading from the gulf of follonica in the tyrrhenian sea to the colline metallifere it aims to document and analyze the form and timeframe of economic growth in this part of the mediterranean which took place between the 7th and the 12thc central to this is an understanding of the processes of change in human settlements in the natural and farming landscapes in relation to the exploitation of resources and in the implementation of differing political strategies this volume brings together the research presented at the first neu med workshop held in siena on 11 12 april 2017 the aim of the workshop was to draw up an initial survey of research and related work on the project one and a half years after its inception the project is composed of several research units each unit covers an aspect of the interdisciplinary research underpinning the neu med project each with their own methodology for this first volume of results it was decided not to give an account of all the work carried out within all the units but to select those lines of investigation which at the end of the first year and a half have made it possible to articulate and develop an interdisciplinary research strategy
