the last of the four major romances by nathaniel hawthorne and was published in 1860 the marble faun written on the eve of the american civil war is set in a fantastical italy the romance mixes elements of a fable pastoral gothic novel and travel guide this romance focuses on four main characters miriam hilda kenyon and donatello miriam is a beautiful painter with an unknown past throughout the novel she is compared to many other women including eve beatrice cenci judith and cleopatra miriam is pursued by a mysterious threatening man who is her evil genius through life hilda is an innocent copyist she is compared to the virgin mary and the white dove her simple unbendable moral principles can make her severe in spite of her tender heart miriam and hilda are often contrasted kenyon is a sculptor who represents rationalist humanism he cherishes a romantic affection towards hilda donatello the count of monte beni is often compared to adam and is in love with miriam donatello amazingly resembles the marble faun of praxiteles and the novel plays with the characters belief that the count may be a descendant of the antique faun hawthorne however withholds a definite statement even in the novel s concluding chapters and postscript
